Powerboating Courses.

- Comfortable warm clothes
- Wellington boots, waterproof clothing
- In Winter or cold weather: hat, buff or scarf & gloves.
- In Summer or warm weather: sunhat, sunscreen & sunglasses.
- A full change of clothes and shoes.

ULAC provide wetsuits, buoyancy aids all specialised equipment.
Please note there are no hair dryers in the changing rooms.

We do advise visitors to bring whatever food or refreshments they may require during the duration of their visit as there are no canteen/shop facilities on site or alternatively participants may wish to go into Killaloe/Ballina during the lunch break. However please be aware that lunch break is one hour only.
